

# SCHEDULE OF PAPER & POSTER PRESENTATIONS

The 19<sup>th</sup> International and 55<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference of ELTAI features two kinds of presentation sessions:

1. **Paper Presentation Sessions:** These highlight completed or ongoing research, classroom innovations, and reflective professional practices. Each paper presentation is allocated 15 minutes, followed by a combined Q&A after all presentations in the session.
2. **Poster Presentation Sessions:** These offer an interactive, conversational format for sharing ideas in a visual medium. Posters will be displayed at the designated venue (Island, Block-1) from 09:00 – 10:15 am on 13 November 2025, during which presenters will stand by their posters to interact with participants.

These sessions provide a platform for educators, researchers, and practitioners to share their work, exchange ideas, and engage with emerging perspectives in English language and literature education. Participants are encouraged to **attend both paper and poster sessions**, even when the topics differ from their own. **Engaging in others' work broadens perspectives, sparks new questions, and promotes meaningful academic dialogue and collaboration.** Such interactions help strengthen research culture and enrich the collective conference experience.
